

York Municipal Social Services Review Board Minutes

November 19, 2020

Motion by Pat Conner, second by Bob Luttman, to recommend the Town donate \$100 to Maine Public Broadcasting. Approved unanimously.

Discussion of requested forwarded to committee by Steve Burns from Habitat for Humanity. They indicated they have money still available from 2017 and 2018 they have not spent due to lack of appropriate referrals for weatherization. They have requested to use this unspent money to service clients from outside of Town of York but who reside in York County. They will still give York residents priority for weatherization services but would like to service clients in need of these services. Committee discussed and have no objections to this request.

Pat Conner informed the Board the Town received 8 applications for funding 5 less than last year. The 5 agencies who did not apply were contacted by Board members to make sure they were aware of the deadline for applying for funding.

The Board discussed the following FY22 applicants:

- Sweetser- request for an increase of \$1000.
- Crossroads House – Pat will contact to discuss the lack of referrals for York referrals
- Caring Unlimited- increase in request from \$3800 to \$7500

Next meeting December 3, 2020 to present 3 additional agencies.
